Dear friends,

Welcome to the third newsletter of the Team2Share: Integrated Training & Teaching for Learning further aiming Knowledge Sharing Across Generations project, co-financed by the European Commission through the Erasmus+ Programme. The current issue will update you on the information regarding the background and rationale of the proposal, the participants, the objectives, activities undergone by the consortium partners and expected results.

The main aim is an assessment performance and monitoring progress of learning outcomes and allow us to maintain control of the new methodology, coping with challenging problems, and prepare a positive adaptive response.

Target groups are:

- 1) primary target group: trainers in adult education, mentors, educators
- 2) secondary target group: adults, at-risk young people, older adults, women, who are educationally disadvantaged people, most of whom had bad school experiences.

Trainers can adjust their instruction to address those challenges, and provide continuing improvements to support trainers, with bad previous experiences. This can help people to stay involved and motivated and achieve better learning outcomes.

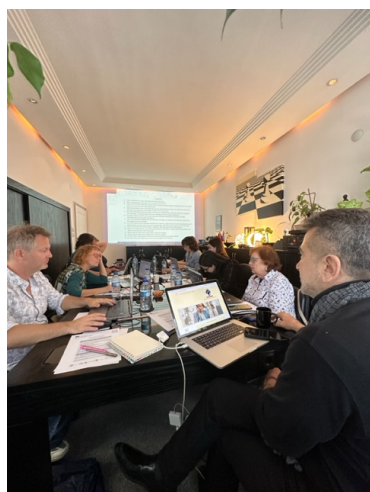

## Team2Share Transnational Project meeting in Kalamata, GR

The Team2Share project held its second transnational project meeting in Ankara (Turkey) between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> of May 2023, hosted by Turkish partner POINT LLC.

The partners checked the project timetable and agreed that the implementation period for IO1 – App for Trainers' Training and IO2 – App for Trainees was respected.



Both intellectual outputs had been finalised and met the project application requests.

The meeting continued with Overview of IO3 - Guidelines for Formative Monitoring and Assessment of learning outcomes Team2Share progress and decided on the final format.

Next, the partners shared their comments regarding the testing and evaluation of IO1 and IO2.

Finally, they also discussed about the dissemination and exploitation activities for the project results on social media and during national workshops and European conferences.

For sustainability of the "Training programme for trainers/teachers/mentors working with low-skilled adults/Training programme for low-skilled adults" and for providing a handy and state-of-the-art product that will be easily used, Team2Share developed these intellectual outputs again on an Android application so that end users would have extremely easy access through their mobiles and/or tablets.

The **Team2Share App for Trainers** answers the need of teachers/trainers/mentors to have and use various other tools, methods, and methodologies suitable for low-skilled adults that have difficulty learning or training in the classic/formal system. A well-known learning phenomenon is that the latest learned contents are forgotten at first. By repeating and rephrasing, the learning material can be stored more effectively in long-term memory.

The **Team2Share App for Trainees** answers the needs of low-skilled adults for more suitable learning/training methods that help them learn and integrate notions easily and thoroughly, which might be difficult to achieve in the conventional learning and training systems.

The application includes speaking/storytelling Avatars presenting course contents as well as practical hints for these users; this is an innovative method appropriate not only for children but also for adults and especially for low-skilled adults.
